Anthony Eggert CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSIONER

Anthony Eggert was appointed in January 2010 and fills the Environmentalist position on the five-member Commission. Before his appointment to the energy commission, Eggert served for two years as Science and Technology Policy Advisor to the chair of the California Air Resources Board. In 2007 he was advisor on energy and climate policy to the Office of Federal Governmental Relations for the University of California and the California Governor's office in Washington DC.

Currently, he serves as Presiding Member of the Efficiency Committee and as Associate Member on the Transportation Committee, AB 32 Implementation (Ad Hoc Committee) and the Federal Stimulus Program (Ad Hoc Committee).



Dan Reicher DIRECTOR, CLIMATE CHANGE AND ENERGY INITIATIVES, GOOGLE

Dan W. Reicher joined Google in 2007 where he serves as Director of Climate Change and Energy Initiatives focused on policy, investment, engineering and information to advance clean energy and confront climate change. He has over 25 years of experience in energy and environmental technology, policy, finance and law, including serving at the U.S. Department of Energy in the Clinton Administration. He recently was a member of President Obama's Transition Team where he focused on the energy portions of the stimulus package and an advisor to the Obama campaign on energy and climate issues.

Mr. Reicher is also a member of the National Academy of Sciences Board on Energy and Environmental Systems, co-chairman of the board of the American Council on Renewable Energy, and a member of the boards of AltaRock Energy Inc, the American Council for an Energy Efficient Economy, the Apollo Alliance, and the University of California Davis Energy Efficiency Center.

Dorothy Rothrock is Vice President of Government Relations for CMTA. Before coming to CMTA in February 2000 she consulted on energy and telecommunications regulatory issues for industrial energy users, policy advocates, and economic research firms. She began her career at Portland General Corporation as an attorney, moving to management positions in commercial operations, public affairs and power marketing prior to relocating to California in 1990. Ms Rothrock graduated from University of Oregon and Lewis and Clark Law School, joining the Oregon Bar in 1980 and the California Bar in 1997.



Brian Sager CO-FOUNDER, NANOSOLAR

Brian Sager is co-founder of San Jose-based Nanosolar, a solar power technology company that has raised more than half-a-billion dollars in funds since it was started in 2002. Nanosolar uses printing press technology to produce sheets of solar cells, more than 1 million a month, at facilities in San Jose and Germany.

Prior to Nanosolar, Sager led a high-growth biotechnology practice at Ernst & Young where he advised private and public companies at all stages of growth on corporate finance issues, R&D portfolio management, and technology licensing.
